WHAT ARE THE MINISTRY'S PROVINCIAL AND DEMONSTRATION SCHOOLS?

The Ministry operates Provincial and Demonstration Schools throughout Ontario for deaf, blind, deaf-blind, and severely learning disabled students, as well as those whose learning disabilities are associated with attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD). Residential programs are offered at the schools Monday to Friday, for students who live too far from school to travel daily.
