

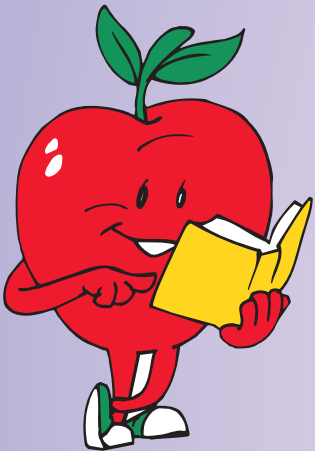

Train volunteers to effectively read with students

Host Family Literacy information evenings

Provide literacy tip sheets for parents to use at home

Give parents lists of good reading material for children

Enhance School Library collections for students to borrow

Organize book fairs for students and families

Encourage parents to visit the school to hear local authors

Present sessions for parents of pre-kindergarten students to help prepare their child for reading and writing in school
